SECTION 108.22 (9) OF THE STATUTES PROVIDES AS FOLLOWS :

' IT WAS NOT ESTABLISHED THAT THE APPELLANT OWNED AT LEAST 20 PERCENT INTEREST IN FALLS VENDING SERVICE, INC. HE EXERCISED NO CONTROL, SUPERVISION, OR RESPONSIBILITY FOR FILING CONTRIBUTION REPORTS OR MAKING PAYMENTS OR MAKING PAYMENTS OF CONTRIBUTIONS. THEREFORE, THE CONDITIONS REQUIRED IN SECTION 108.22(9) OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES WERE NOT SATISFIED FOR IMPOSING PERSONAL LIABILITY ON HIM FOR UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION TAX DELINQUENCIES.

THE APPEAL TRIBUNAL THEREFORE FINDS THAT LEO E. WANTA IS NOT PERSONALLY LIABLE FOR THE DELINQUENT UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION TAXES OF FALLS VENDING SERVICES, INC., WITHIN THE MEANING OF SECTION 108.22(9) OF THE STATUTES.

Updating your information in respect of the civil law suit against Mr. Kurt-Paul Becker and his business associates, I enclose copy of the judgment of the Frankfurt Court of Appeal of May 5, 1994 which confirms the judgment of the first instance granting Mr. Lang's claim in the amount of US\$ 500.000. The defendants have the right to appeal to the Federal Supreme Court.

Dear Mr. President:

As you are aware, during November/December 1989, I was approached by Dr. Hassan A. Meguid, allegedly representing a Iranian Group, as shown below;

- (a) RAFIT DOUC - Chief of Iranian Revolutionary Guards - Teheran
- (b) " TUKAN " - Chief of I.R.I.A.F. - Teheran Headquarters
- (c) Monica Bendeck - Dubai / Abu Dhabi intermediary
- (d) " HORMOS " - Teheran official of General Staff Hdqtrs

Several weeks ago in consultation with my Controller RAC William Lecates, U.S. CUSTOMS SERVICE / NASHVILLE under USA assigned cover as -

File code name ; Frank B. Ingram

File name/number ; FBI (SA 32 NV)

As I was instructed and cleared to continue communications while the " go old guys " upstairs determine the next course of action, besides running through the side door as discovered later, based on my reporting data.

Later I was requested by the Iranian group to attend a special meeting in Abu Dhabi, which is to include the Dubai Ambassador to discuss details. On March 16, 1990, I requested again USA authorization to attend, or I would not consider further communications or Iranian requests; inter alia Based on these sensitive requests to the upstairs level personnel for USA advice and direction, I was informed that RAC Lecates would no longer be my Controller, and since " Uncle Bill " has passed away, the directive no suggested I contact Vice President Dan Quayle or President Bush, for vari security reasons, among other things. The " Good Old Boys " upstairs have received all of the pertinent data and related documentation from Nashvil

Since I was not contacted in Amman early Monday thru Wednesday, this week relative to the Iranian meeting request(s), I will " stand down " on this sensitive situation, unless I receive direction and authorization.

A department deputy's initial determination held: that Leo E. Wanta was personally liable for the payment of delinquent unemployment compensation taxes owed by Falls Vending Service, Inc., in the amount of \$45,995.31, including late filing fees and interest, computed through August 31, 1988.

Based on the applicable records and evidence in this case, the appeal tribunal makes the following

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

In October of 1980, Leo Wanta, the appellant in this case, was offered the opportunity to purchase the ownership interest of Falls Vending Service, Inc. On June 26, 1981, he entered into an agreement to purchase 200 shares of corporate stock within 15 days if everything met his approval. He became suspicious of discrepancies and misrepresentations of the seller and the sale was not consummated. He was promised by the seller and a financial institution that the sale would occur. Therefore, he continued to manage the corporation. On June 27, 1983, a petition for Chapter 11 bankruptcy was filed by Leo Wanta. Shortly thereafter, he was discharged.

The issue to be decided in this case is whether the appellant, Leo E. Wanta, should be held personally liable for the payment of delinquent unemployment contributions.

Section 108.22(9) of the statutes provides as follows:

(9) Any officer or any employee holding at least 20% of the ownership interest of a corporation subject to this chapter, who has control or supervision of or responsibility for filing contribution reports or making payment of contributions, and who wilfully fails to file such reports or to make such payments to the department, may be found personally liable for such amounts, including interest, tardy payment or filing fees, costs and other fees, in the event that after proper proceedings for the collection of such amounts, as provided in this chapter, the corporation is unable to pay such amounts to the department. The personal liability of such officer or employee as provided in this subsection survives dissolution, reorganization, bankruptcy, receivership, assignment for the benefit of creditors, judicially confirmed extension or composition, or any analogous situation of the corporation and shall be set forth in a determination or decision issued under s. 108.10.

It was not established that the appellant owned at least 20 percent interest in Falls Vending Service, Inc. He exercised no control, supervision, or responsibility for filing contribution reports or making payments of contributions. Therefore, the conditions required in section 108.22(9) of the Wisconsin statutes were not satisfied for imposing personal liability on him for unemployment compensation tax delinquencies.

The appeal tribunal therefore finds that Leo E. Wanta is not personally liable for the delinquent unemployment compensation taxes of Falls Vending Service, Inc., within the meaning of section 108.22((9) of the statutes.

DECISION

The department deputy's initial determination is reversed. Accordingly, Leo E. Wanta is not personally liable for the unemployment compensation tax delinquencies of Falls Vending Service, Inc.

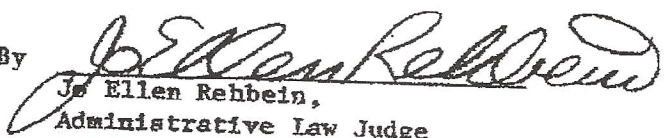
