Upon information and belief, on or about March 31, 1993, a complaint was filed and an arrest warrant was issued by the United States District Court for the Western District of Wisconsin charging the defendant LEO EMIL WANTA with unlawfully traveling in interstate and foreign commerce from the State of Wisconsin to avoid prosecution for tax evasion, a felony under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, in violation of Title 18, U.S.C., Section 1073.

The source of my information and the grounds for my belief are as follows:

 I have received a copy of the arrest warrant issued by the Western District of Wisconsin. A copy of that document is attached hereto. Also attached is the complaint and affidavit in support of that warrant.

2. The defendant LEO EMIL WANTA was arrested at JFK Airport at approximately 3:10 p.m. on November 17, 1993. At the time of the arrest, the defendant had on his person a Wisconsin driver's license in the name of LEO EMIL WANTA. The defendant also stated to me, "I'm the one you are looking for," and confirmed that he is LEO EMIL WANTA.

WHEREFORE, I respectfully request that the defendant LEO EMIL WANTA be dealt with according to law.
