Stuck in the Promised Land


Israel: With unrest rising, many settlers want out

BUT EVERYONE IN THE MILitant Jewish settlement of Kiryat Arlas thinks it's the promised land, "We went because of the money; it was cheop to get an apartment there," says Sanih Malul, who moved to Kiryat Arba III years ago. Malul and her husband, Avi. raising four children in u tearful place surrounded by enraged Palestinians, often thought of moving to Jerusalem. But they couldn't afford to. Then Baruch Goldstein, a Kiryat Aria resident, garned down 20 Muslim worshipers in meanly flebron, and everything changed. "My b-year-old said to me, "I'm niraid the Arabs will kill me now!" recalls Surah. The Maluly demanded government help-and with a \$275 mountily subsidy they were while to real a line apartment in

Thousands of Jews living in other settlements deep in the Israeli-necupied West bank and Chiza Strip want to get out, too. But it's not so easy. They were lured there by government offers of huge mortgages at rock-bottom rates, at a time when Israel's leaders wanted Jews to populate Arab tands captured in 1967. The sectors lungh formers they rould never afford in Israel moper. Let now that Israel is preparing to trude land for neace, the same houses have plunged in value. "Many families want to heave," says Malak, who can't find a hayer to her against ment in Kievat Arba, "But they don't have the money to make that choice."

The trick is to survive Pulestinian stones. ballets and heatils entil the government of Prime Musister Vitzhak Rabin offers compensation, then take the money and can Settlers recall the precedent set at Yamit, the Smal settlement returned to Egypt as part of the 1979 peace treaty. Palestinians will think we are weak." That approach has left many settlers feeling like pawns in an increasingly dangerous game, just last week the Islamic militant group Humus issued a warning to Jews living in certain West Bank and Gaza settlements: leave by March 15 or face increased attacks. The threat is not empty bluster. In February Hamas gunmen shot dead a pregnant wonun who was traveling between Tel Aviv and the suburban-style settlement of Ariel, More recently, nervous Israelt soldiers killed on Ariel resident who was driving at night - they thought the settler was a Palestiniaa terrosist.

So far the government is providing only minimal assistance to help relocate lowincome families desperate to get out. Estimates for the cost of fully compensating most of the 125,000 settlers range up to \$10 billion, "Somebody will have to pay

> for it," says Meirora, who suggests that Saudi Arabia could help if settlements were used to house Palestinians in the future. Washington is another likely candidate, Israel got a pledge in 1992 for \$10 billion in U.S. loan guarantees to help ale sorb Jewish immigrants. tice will be launching an investigation into Rubinstein in the more recent case.

"Following the policy of the department on matters involving allegations of prosecutorial misconduct, the U.S. attorney in Tampa has referred the matter to the department's Office of Professional Responsibility for appropriate review," said Chris Watney, a department spokeswoman.

This is the second time the 11th Circuit has thrown out a conviction because of misconduct by Rubinstein.

In 1994, the court overturned the convictions of Tom and Penny Crutchfield for illegally importing iguanas. The court criticized Rubinstein for "intentional misconduct," saying he had improperly attacked the character of the defendants and their witnesses.

"These attacks often continued

even after the [frial judge] instructed the prosecutor as to their impropriety," the court wrote. "The prejudicial effect of this misconduct cannot be disputed."

In the more recent case, the court criticized Rubinstein not for his court-room behavior but for what he did during the secret grand jury proceedings while seeking indictments against the shrimp company.

Sigma International Inc. and two of its executives were accused of selling millions of dollars worth of bad shrimp. After obtaining the indictment, Rubinstein took the case to trial, winning guilty verdicts against the company; its vice-president, William Andrew Walton; and the plant manager, Charles Sternisha.

All three appealed.

A three-judge panel of the appeals court issued a rare and scathing rebuke of Rubinstein on Nov. 30, 1999. It ruled that Rubinstein had lied to the

grand jury, tried to rush its deliberations and made improper remarks to it about unrelated crimes.

Nevertheless, the appeals panel did not throw out the indictments.

But prosecutors, stung by the harsh criticism, came to Rubinstein's defense. They asked the appeals panel to reconsider, arguing that the initial ruling was incorrect and unfair. The defendants also asked for reconsideration.

The result was a second blow more stunning than the first.

Armed with new evidence, the same three-judge panel ruled that Rubinstein's misconduct was so bad the indictments should be thrown out.

"On a national level, this is almost unheard of," said Charles Wolfram, a legal ethics professor at Cornell University who is a leading expert in his field.

"The federal court of appeals is just

sick to death of prosecutorial misconduct and not being able to do anything about it," Wolfram said. "This is a shot across the prosecution's bow."

The Sigma case may prompt defendants across the country to seek reviews of their grand jury proceedings. It is also a case that may end up before the U.S. Supreme Court, Wolfram said.

The U.S. attorney's office declined to comment on the ruling or say whether it will appeal. Rubinstein also declined to comment.

Whatever happens next, Tampa lawyer William Jung, who defended Sigma, said the company will continue to fight.

"We will continue to litigate this case," Jung said. "Hopefully someone in the U.S. attorney's office will give it a real stem-to-stern review ... and put this old shaggy dog of a case to rest."

If the case is resolved in Sigma's favor, the company will get a full refund

of \$1.4 million in fines it has paid as a result of its conviction. "The only question is whether it will be with interest," Jung said.

The two executives, Walton and Sternisha, have been free pending their appeals. Each had been sentenced to between one and two years in prison.

The U.S. attorney's office here was also stung by another ruling in 2000. The Florida Bar asked the state Supreme Court to suspend federal prosecutor Karen Cox for three years for allowing a witness to testify using a phony name during a 1998 trial in state court.
