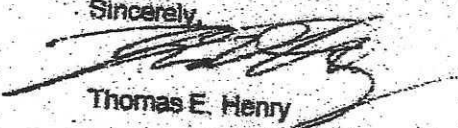
I am responding to the letter attached hereto from Haley D. Collums whom I assume is under your offices administration and authority. It would be most appreciated if you would review the letter previously sent to the Honorable Secretary of State Colin Powell (attached hereto) and the letter sent to Attorney General John Ashcroft (attached hereto).

For the purpose of this communication I will not address my specific objections and explanations of the misstatements and improper characterization of several points of contention referenced in the second full paragraph of Ms. Collums letter. I also note that Ambassador Wanta is not making application for a job. If Ms. Collums or the offices of the Secretary of State contain records that Ambassador Wanta's current relationship with the United States Government has been terminated then a copy of all documentation pertaining to his termination sent to me immediately would be appreciated. Additionally, counsel for Ambassador Wanta are under the impression that for termination of employment various legal issues would need to be resolved and Ambassador Wanta would be required to complete an H5 debriefing as a part of the termination process. I would be most interested in discussing further under proper authority and approval from Ambassador Wanta.

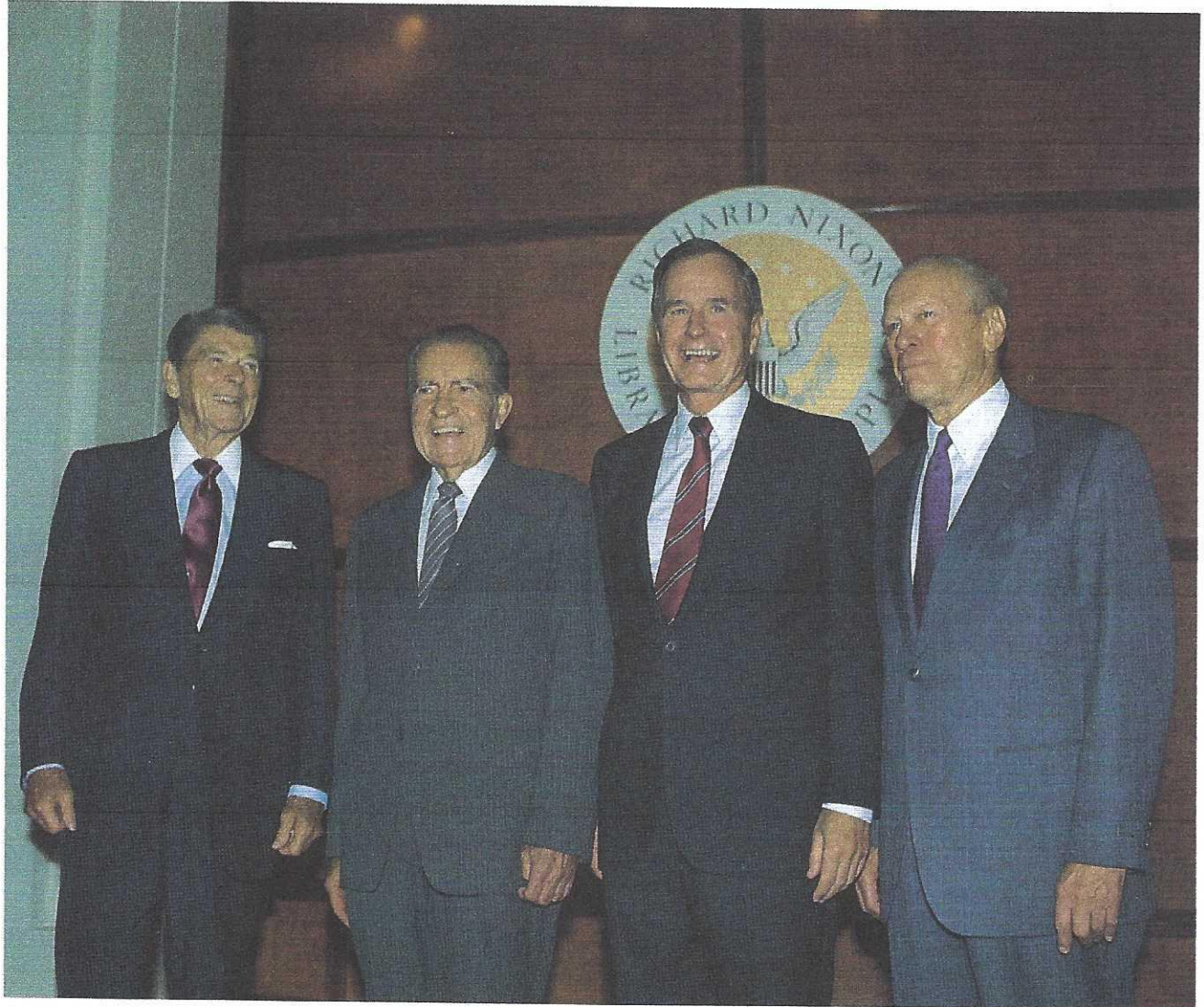
In addition to the documents attached to this letter I have learned that Madam Eva Telek forwarded various documents to the residence of Secretary of State Powell that clearly identify issues and points of concern that cause our confusion in receiving the letter from Ms. Collums.

At your earliest convenience I would appreciate your investigation and/or inquiry into this matter and advise of the position of the State Department concerning the attached letters and what if any records are available in State Department files concerning the employment of Ambassador Wanta. If this matter is not within your office authority or jurisdiction, I would respectfully request you forward the same to the Vice President and the Attorney General. I look forward to receiving responses and cooperation that are more in context with the scope and intent of the letters that have been sent to each respective individual over the past several months. It may be of assistance to you to make inquiry of the reference (Re:) identifications as an integrated person and/or persons as part of your research.

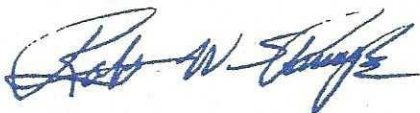

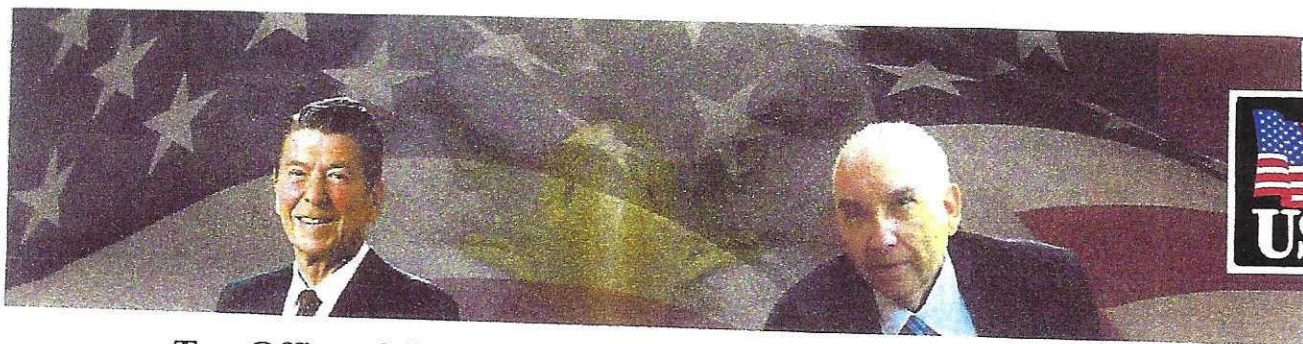

Dear Mr. Heger:

The White House has asked me to reply to your letter dated September 15, 2001 on behalf of Mr. Leo E. Wanta, aka Lee E. Wanta. Your letter raised certain issues, namely the allegedly illegal extradition of Mr. Wanta to the United States in 1993, the charges against him in the State of Wisconsin, and Mr. Wanta's desire to return to active service with the U.S. Government.

The Office of the Legal Adviser, Law Enforcement and Intelligence of the U.S. Department of State, and the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of International Affairs are the federal offices tasked with international extradition matters. Neither office has a record of a formal extradition request having been presented for Mr. Wanta by the United States. Based on the information currently available, Mr. Wanta was deported to the United States from Switzerland in November 1993. His U.S. passport was revoked based on an unlawful flight to avoid prosecution warrant issued by the U.S. District Court in Wisconsin. It also appears that prior to his deportation, Mr. Wanta was under arrest in Switzerland on local fraud charges. If there is a dispute regarding the charges against Mr. Wanta in Wisconsin, it should be referred to the Wisconsin judicial authorities.

With regard to Mr. Wanta's desire to return to active service, this office is not authorized to offer appointments within U.S. Government offices. If your client wishes to pursue such employment, please be advised that all candidates for appointment to federal positions must meet qualification requirements under applicable U.S. law and regulations governing federal appointment.

We hope that this information is helpful to you. Please do not hesitate to contact us if we can be of further assistance.

Your letter of May 21, 2001 to the Vice President, seeking his assistance with a state clemency matter for Ambassador Leo E. Wanta, was forwarded to this office for response. I apologize for the delay in replying. The President's clemency power under the Constitution is limited to federal offenses. As a matter of policy, neither the President nor the Vice President make recommendations or otherwise seek to intervene in state clemency matters. Whether to grant clemency to a state offender is a matter within the authority of state officials to decide. Accordingly, this office is unable to assist you with your request.

Court: IRS wrong in tax evasion case

SAN FRANCISCO — A federal appeals court has ruled the Internal Revenue Service committed fraud and acted deceptively after giving secret deals to two pilots in return for their testimony against 1,300 other pilots who had bought into the same tax shelters.

The 9th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals on Friday overturned a previous ruling against the pilots who were found guilty of tax evasion and were ordered to pay more than \$2 billion in penalties.

In order to remedy the IRS misconduct, the court ordered that all the pilots should receive the same deal that one of the pilots received.

As part of the secret deal, pilot John Thompson escaped paying the taxes he owed and received a \$60,000 refund through falsified tax returns prepared with help from the IRS. Thompson used the refund to pay his legal fees. He also collected \$20,000 in interest, according to the ruling.

IRS lawyers Kenneth McWade and William Sims, who prosecuted the case, never revealed to the tax court that the two pilots' cases had been settled, much less revealed the conditions of the settlement.

The ruling requires the IRS to pay tens of million of dollars in tax refunds, interest and legal fees to the pilots who paid the disputed taxes more than 20 years ago.
